4. Discussion	a. Club Kit. Junior kit – the purple is discontinued, and the senior purple will be discontinued in the new year. Some alternative suppliers have been identified but they were very expensive. JT suggested reverting to the Royal Blue previously used. No objection was made to this suggestion. i.	Safeguarding – Keiron, No matters reported for meeting. On-line safeguarding courses now readily available.	
ii.	Finance – KM forwarded report (Summary Item 3 below)– region holding own at the moment but venue costs for next year's events are very high. Zoe Holloway is looking into these costs. The region's savings account is still frozen with Santander and KM is unable to access it. JT stated that Andrew from WA has been extremely helpful in dealing with the bank to resolve the issues of signatories on the account. Fees for regional champs will need to be increased to help cover the costs of hosting. £2 was suggested for cross country events and no objection received.	
iii.	a. General Council – LH was unable to attend the last Gen Council meeting, but JT picked up 2 points: Lack of engagement from schools for events is a concern, across all disciplines. She asked members for suggestions to improve

Recently courses have had to be cancelled last minute by Rob Campion so he has asked the regional councils to encourage people to make sure that they attend courses that they have booked onto.</p>	
iv.	<p>Track & Field Regional indoor champs – JT thanked Blaenau Gwent, RVRC and Cwmbran Harriers for providing volunteers to support the event. No volunteers from Newport were present, although they had a considerable number of athletes competing. She asked clubs to consider volunteering at future events. 2026 – Aberdare booked for 9 May. Inter-regional, it's the turn of East Wales to host this event, will be 13 June again at Aberdare.</p>
